**Testing Instructions:**

- Report to Spring Oaks Middle School (2150 Shadowdale) on **Saturday, October 15, 2011, at 7:45 a.m.** Entrance to the testing site is only through the main door. **Student pick-up** will also be at the main door **approximately at 11:00 a.m.**
- **Bring photo ID**
- **Bring the ticket you receive via email.**
- Bring #2 pencils (not mechanical). No highlighters are allowed.
- No backpacks or cell phones are allowed. No food or beverage (no water) is allowed in classrooms.
- Bring a calculator. Students may **NOT** share calculators. Students may **NOT** use pocket organizers, PowerBooks, or portable/handheld computers; electronic writing pads or pen-input/stylus-driven devices; cell phone calculators; or calculators with a QWERTY (typewriter-like) keypad, paper tape, that make noise or “talk,” or that require an electrical outlet.
