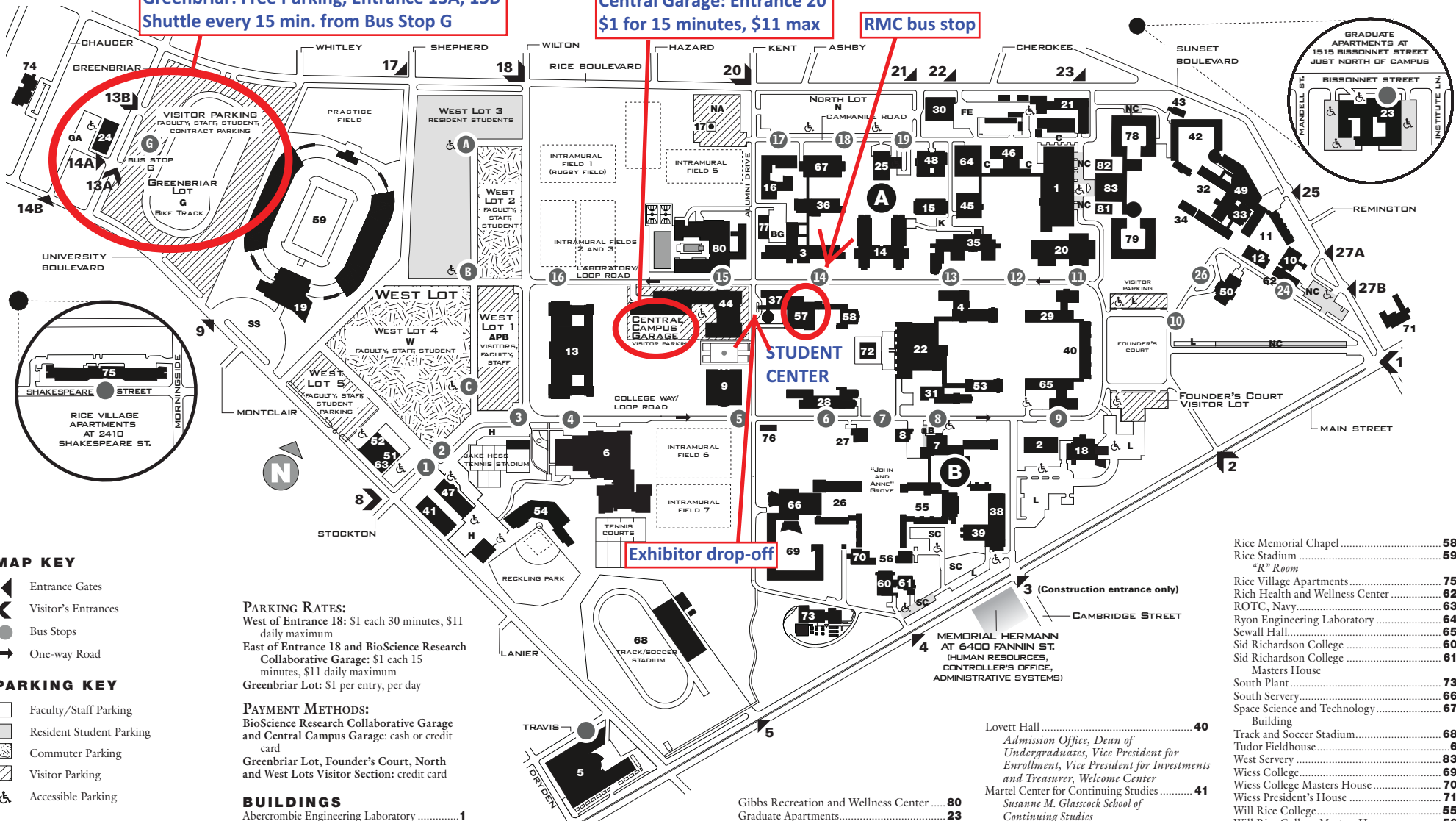
RICE UNIVERSITY CAMPUS MAP

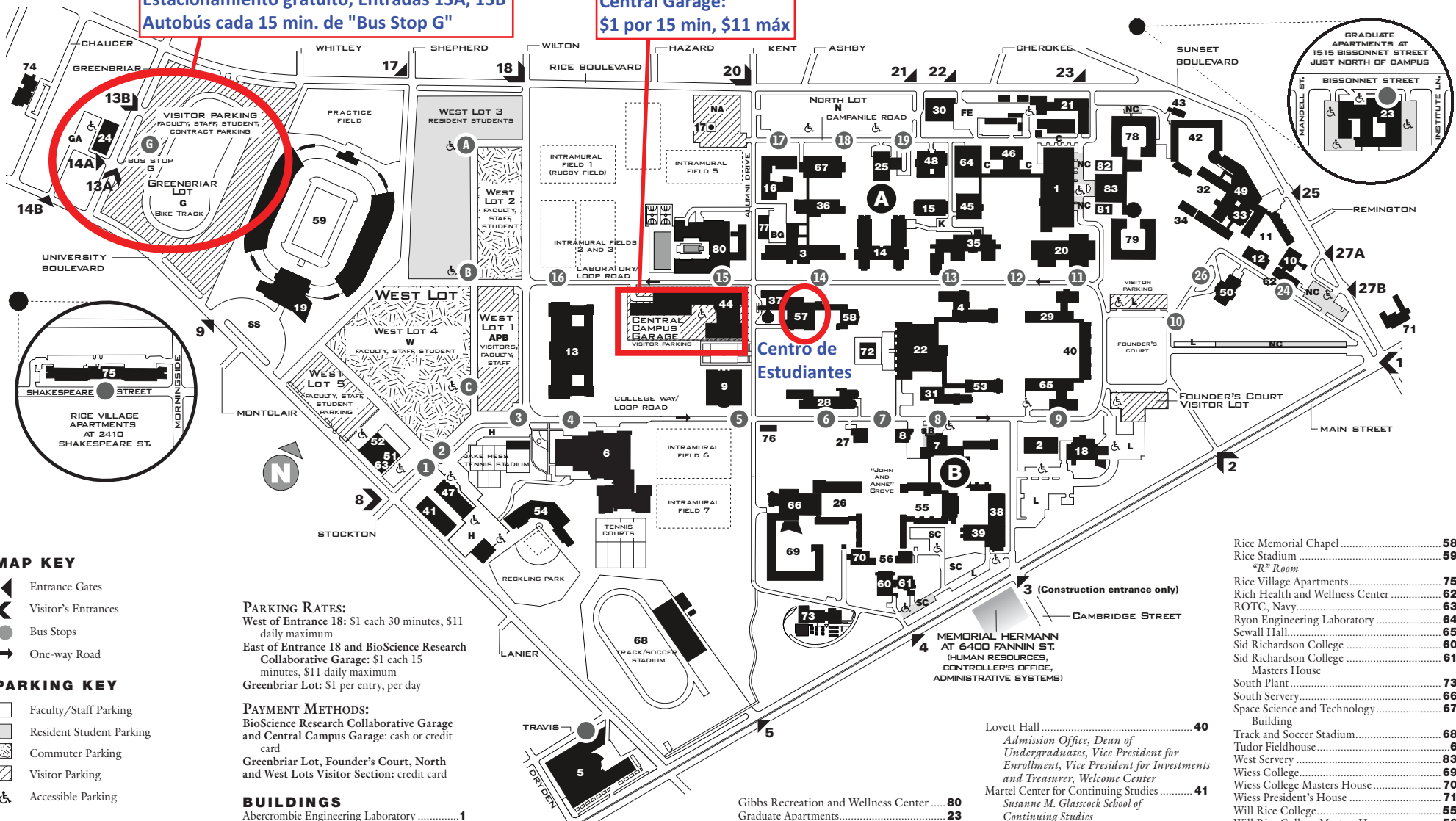
