FACT Last year's Employee Campaign was so successful, SBEF granted scholarships of \$1500 to each of the 43 students who applied.

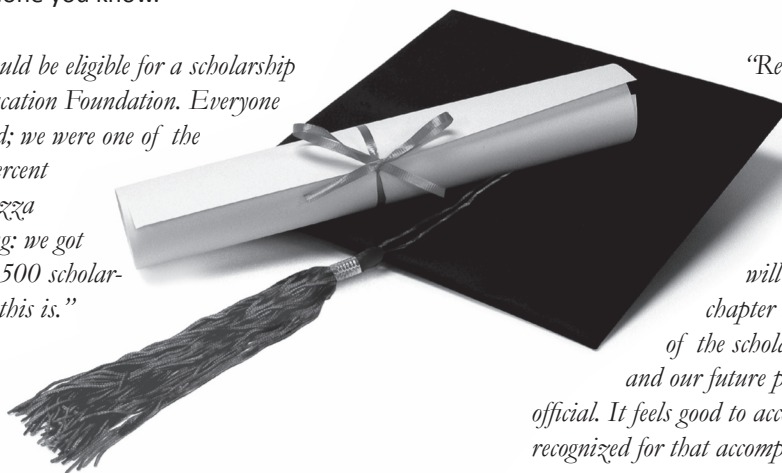
