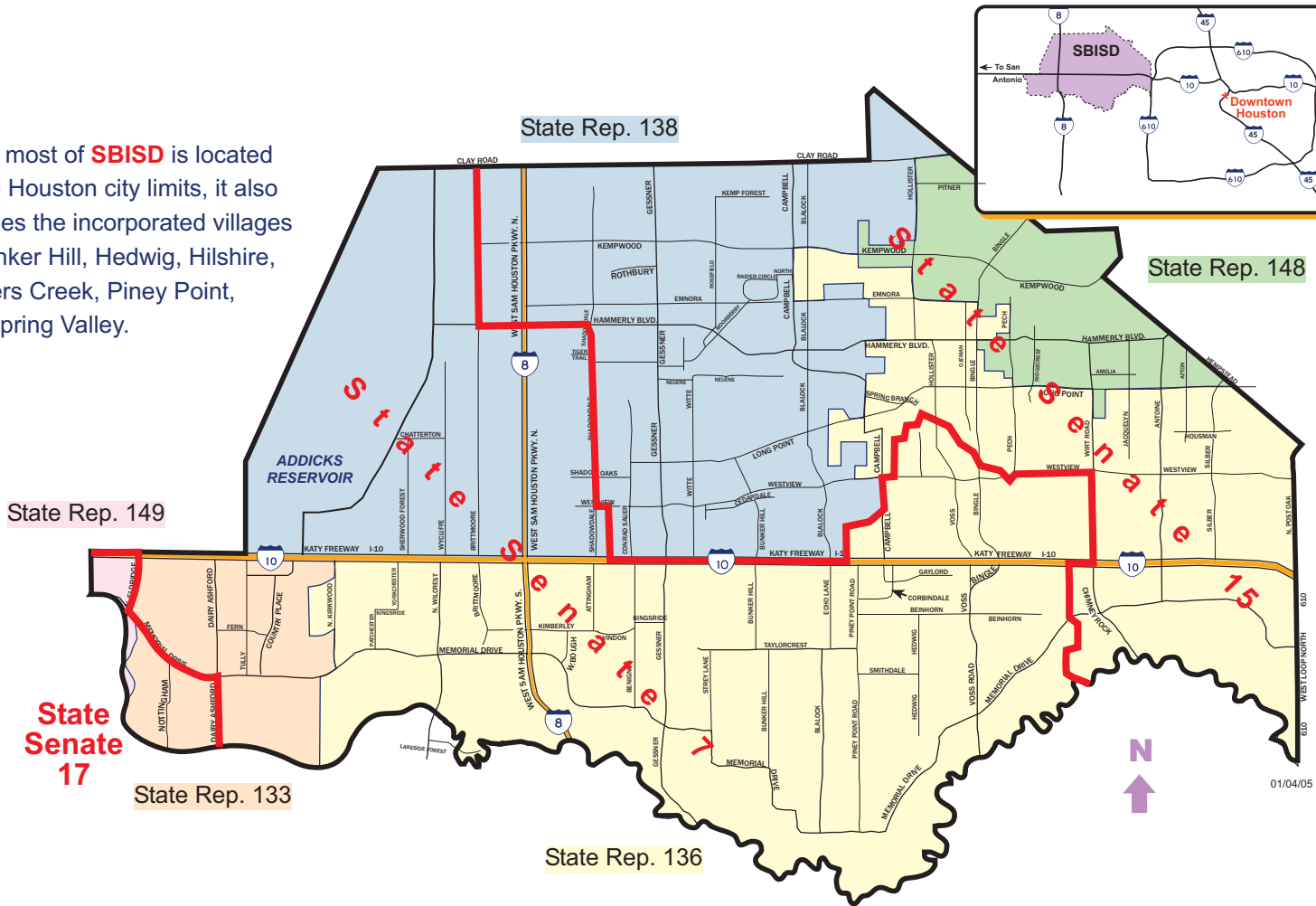




The Spring Branch Independent School District (SBISD)
