

## Spring Branch Independent School District 2009 Accountability Summary

- The 2007-2008 Annual Dropout Rate<sup>1</sup> for grades 7 and 8.

<b>Academically Acceptable</b>	<i>below the exemplary and recognized standards but exceeds the academically unacceptable standards</i>
<b>Academically Unacceptable</b>	<i>below the state clearly unacceptable performance standard and does not meet required improvement</i>
