

Mentor FAQs – Reopening of school 2020-2021

1. Will mentors be allowed in campuses?

All district facilities will be closed to nonessential visitors, parents and volunteers for the first semester. Currently, returning mentors may connect with mentees via email (available for all grades), letters (available for all grades), text (available for grades 6-12), phone call (available for grades 6-12), and videoconferencing (if available).

2. Do returning mentors need to complete the volunteer registration for the 2020-2021 school year?

3. Who do mentors contact regarding their mentee? What if my mentee is in a transition grade (6th & 9th)?
