New & Current Students

New Student Registration

Families new to Spring Branch ISD or families who have moved within SBISD to a different school are encouraged to register before Monday, August 16, the first day of school. Registration forms can be completed online with an email address and phone number. After registering online, appointments will be scheduled at the student's school to submit the following:

- Immunization record certified by a doctor or public health official
- Transcript or Report Card from the last school attended
- Birth certificate or other document suitable as proof of child's identity
- Proof of SBISD residency as needed (Examples: lease agreement or
- mortgage payment book; district tax bill; utility bill with correct name and addresss


Dates and times are subject to change. There is no registration the first day of school. Contact the student's school for additional dates and times beyond the district schedule above.
