Scope of work includes: Replacement of the existing roofing system including the standing seam metal roof, mechanical system upgrades, Library and Collaboration spaces renovation, replacement of skylight panels, new building marquee, replacement of door hardware at classrooms, fire alarm system, security alarm & access control improvements, renovation of existing restrooms, new kindergarten playground equipment, and providing new clearstory windows at collaboration areas.
