Welcome

Travis Stanford welcomed the group, thanked everyone for their participation and reviewed the charge as well as recapped the highlights of the previous meeting.

## <u>AECOM Presentation</u> <u>Facility Assessment Update</u>

Ken English reviewed the schedule of the facility assessment and presented the voting results for the facility condition and overall assessment components prioritization exercises from the previous meeting.

Preliminary estimated cost updates of facility system replacement deficiencies were presented noting that the costs being presented are preliminary estimates and will be refined as reports are further developed. It was also noted that the costs are for construction only and not turnkey.

## **Definition Activity**

Committee members engaged in an activity which required them to work individually as well as in groups to come to a consensus around the definitions listed below as they pertain to the facility assessment: definitions listed below:

- Critical
- Moderate
- Non-Critical

Definitions were recorded on three sheets of chart paper with four recommended definitions on each sheet for Critical, Moderate and Non-Critical. Committee members were given three colored dots and asked to vote for their preferred definition for each. This allowed committee members to make note of the commonalities for each definition among the group.

### **Voting Activity**

Committee members participated in a voting exercise using their mobile devices to classify assessment categories as Critical, Moderate and/or Non-Critical. For example, Building Envelope, is that considered Critical, Moderate or Non-Critical?

In closing, the next steps for the Long Range Committee were outlined as members will be reviewing and discussing more data at the next meeting and presenting an assessment project update to senior staff and the Board of Trustees as to the status of the development of the Long Range Plan.

It is critical for members to understand that each campus' needs are different as well as be aware that the priorities can be adjusted by campus to address critical needs.
