2. What are the major challenges you see SBISD facing in the next two years?

We're moving into an era in which there's a heightened paranoia in regards to school safety. Social emotional learning (SEL) should be woven into the school environment, and I think counseling supports need to be bolstered within the district. SEL training should become a professional development priority for educators within the district, similar to state mandates regarding teachers of Gifted/Talented students.



- 3. What role do you see the DIT having in addressing these challenges? The DIT will need to bolster SEL supports throughout the district and readily be willing to assist with professional development for teachers. The district will need to rethink discipline as it applies to the brain/body connection and other sociocultural factors.
