

Career and Technical Education (CTE) Updates:

- In the Fall 2020 the CTE team took the programming recommendations of the CTE working group regarding CTE programming and implemented 26 program of studies. SBISD began implementation of Phase 2 of this programming work in January 2021.
- In order to accommodate future programming needs, SBISD Planning and Construction and the CTE Department worked this summer with Stantec to develop and complete Educational Specifications for future CTE facilities at secondary campuses and at the central facility (Guthrie Center).
- As a continuation of that programming work, SBISD Planning and Construction and the CTE Department worked this summer with Stantec to develop Educational Specifications.
- In order to meet the needs of our CTE learners who had to adapt to virtual learning this Fall. CTE was able to supply our virtual and face to face learners with the appropriate devices that would accommodate our software and certification standards.



Fine and Performing Arts Updates:

- The Fine Arts Department has completed about two thirds of its bond related work to date.
- Over the past two years, the department has replaced and updated a majority of their expansive instrument inventory (both Band and Orchestra) at all secondary campuses.
- Over the next four years, all four high schools will receive replacement band and drill team field
 - This process will begin this Spring with Stratford HS.
 - The design process for a set of field uniforms takes about six months from beginning to end.
- The replacement of stage curtains at secondary campuses (except SHS and LMS) is scheduled to begin in 2025.

Technology Updates:

Lifecycle Refresh - Student

- Elementary
 - Spring 2021 One-year change to process
 - Operation Connectivity Collaboration between TEA and Region 4 to bridge the digital divide
 - TEA and Harris County will now pay 100% of the cost of devices
 - 5,000 hotspots Delivered to secondary and elementary campuses in September
 - 9,300 iPads Delivered to elementary campuses in October
 - 7,500 Chromebooks Delivered to elementary campuses in December
 - 9,300 iPad cases Delivered to elementary campuses in January

Lifecycle Refresh - Employees

- Instructional and Non-Instructional Staff
 - Replaced over 3,700 computers to date
- Target out-of-warranty (>5 years) devices
- Goal is 100% of devices less than 5 years old

Safety & Security

- Extended Network Availability
 - Phase 1 Feasibility Study Completed Fall 2018
 - Phase 2 Pilot LTE Network
 - Waiting on City of Houston permits for power
 - Next Steps
 - Fiber installation by mid-March
 - Install network equipment by mid-March
 - Test LTE Network at different distances and topographies
















