2. What are the major challenges you see SBISD facing in the next two years? Some challenges the district may face is the increasing influx of second language learners and closing obvious gaps. When the students enter in Pk/K, they are usually already 2 years behind. By the time they make it to 3rd and 4th grade they are barely above 1st or 2nd grade level in reading. This puts a



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tremendous amount of pressure on the teachers to close the gaps. These gaps impact every level from the primary level all the through the secondary levels.

- 3. What role do you see the DIT having in addressing these challenges? The role of DIT would be to implement measures to educate parents and students simultaneously about the challenges so that parents can not only be aware of the challenges that their children may face, but be provided with tools to provide students with prerequisite skills that will prepare them for school prior to prekinder.
