Logical/Mathematical Intelligence

Often called "scientific thinking," this intelligence deals with inductive and deductive thinking/reasoning, numbers and the recognition of abstract patterns.



Verbal/Linguistic Intelligence

This intelligence, which is related to words and language-written and spokendominates most Western educational systems.



This intelligence, which relies on the sense of sight and being able to visualize an object, includes the ability to create Internal mental Images/pictures.





Intrapersonal Intelligence

This intelligence relates to Inner states of being, self-reflection, metacognition (i.e. thinking about thinking). and awareness of spritual realities.



MULTIPLE INTELLIGENCES

Body/Kinesthetic Intelligence

This intelligence is related to physical movement and the knowings/wisdom of the body, including the brain's motor cortex, which controls bodily





Interpersonal Intelligence

This intelligence operates primarily through person-toperson relationships and communication.

Musical/Rhythmic Intelligence

This intelligence is based on the recognition of tonal patterns, including various environmental sounds, and on a sensitivity to rhythm and bests.
