- What qualities do you possess which enable you to make contributions to the DIT? Over the past 18 years of teaching, I have been able to fine tune my craft as an educator. I have taught grades 1-7 in Reading, Writing, Math, and Self Contained. My experience of achieving high student growth, strong classroom management, and relationship building over consecutive years in various grade levels will serve as an asset in DIT. I am able to offer a wide range of experiences. Furthermore, I am highly organized, dedicated, and a problem solver.
- 2. What are the major challenges you see SBISD facing in the next two years? I believe that a major challenge facing SBISD is growth in Math and Reading. I currently teach Reading and feel that there could be some further changes to support this program. It is my belief that one size does not fit all and that in education, it takes more than one resource to provide a strong foundation. Also another challenge is the mental health of many of our students with limited resources available to them within the school. So many



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students are coming to school with real-life problems that prevent them from succeeding in the learning environment.

3. What role do you see the DIT having in addressing these challenges?

I think it would be a great start for DIT to collaborate as a team in addressing and brainstorming resolutions to issues related to planning, staff development, curriculum, and staffing patterns. To collect data across the district from various perspectives in these areas and work toward making these systems more efficient.

4. Please discuss any issue/concern/observation/opportunity you have identified that has not been addressed. I think that SBISD is making great efforts to address areas of need. However, I feel that from a teacher's perspective, that schedules and meetings could be revamped to allow more opportunity to plan and prepare.
