  - Data will be added as they become available
- A "scaled back" PDF version (the "Paper TAPR")
  - Only includes major, statutorily-required data points
  - Designed to allow districts to fulfill their public notification requirements (i.e. public hearing)



## STAAR Highlights

STAAR All Grades

- Economically Disadvantaged students improved in all subjects and at all three levels: Approaches, Meets, and Masters by up to 6 points.
- Students served by Special Education improved in all subjects at the Approaches and Meets levels.
- Students in ESL programs improved in all subjects at the Meets level.

End of Course

- Approaches and Meets — Exceeded state and region in 4 of 5 subjects (English I, Algebra I, Biology, and U.S. History)
- Masters performance at or above state and region in English II, Biology, and U.S. History.
- Impacting Masters performance - 40% of English I tests and 27% of Algebra I tests were submitted as substitute assessments, consequently students not eligible to be counted at the Masters level

### College Readiness Indicators

- Advanced Course/Dual Credit course completion rate across all high school grades increased to the highest district level ever, and exceeded State and Region levels in every subject.
- Advanced Course/Dual Credit course completion rates across all high school grades for Economically Disadvantaged students, Asian, and Hispanic students increased in every subject tested.
- Advanced Course/Dual Credit course completion rates across all high school grades for EL students increased in 3 of 4 subjects.
- District rate of students taking AP/IB tests exceeded State by 13.1 and Region by 11.6 points.

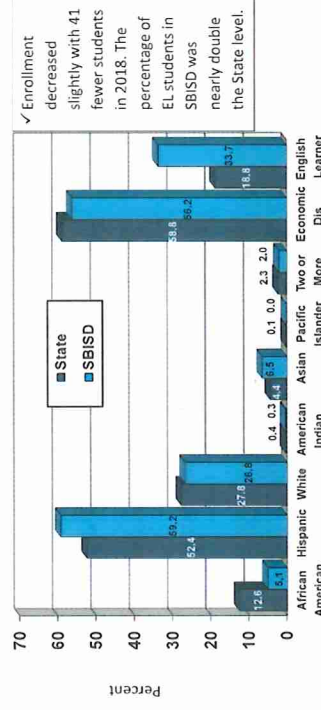
### College Readiness Indicators

- District rate of examinees scoring at or above criterion on AP/IB tests exceeded State by 11.3 and Region by 7.9 points.
- Rate of annual graduates taking the SAT/ACT and scoring at or above the criterion score exceeded state and region.
- District average scores of SAT and ACT exceeded state and region levels.
- Percent of district college ready graduates in ELA and math exceeded state and region.
- Class of 2016 graduates enrolled in Texas institutions of Higher Education, more than 7 of 10 students, 71.0%, completed their first year without developmental courses, exceeding State and Region by widest margins ever.

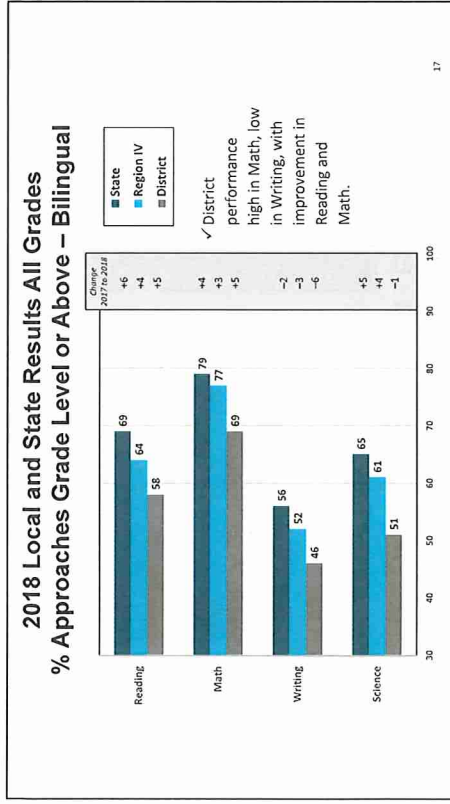
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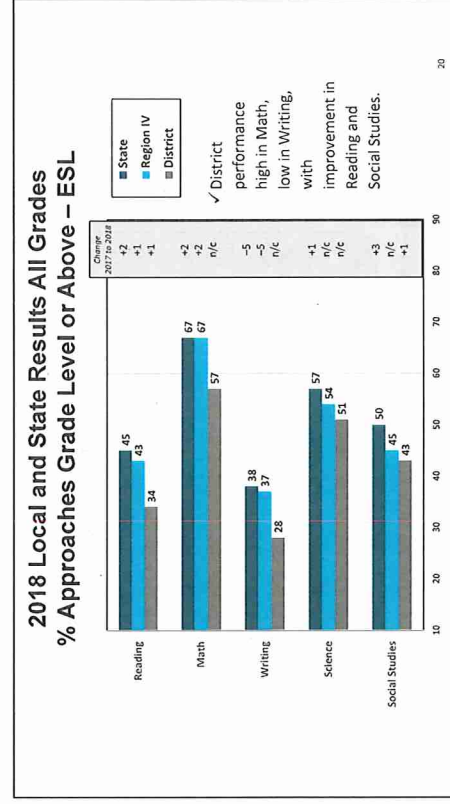
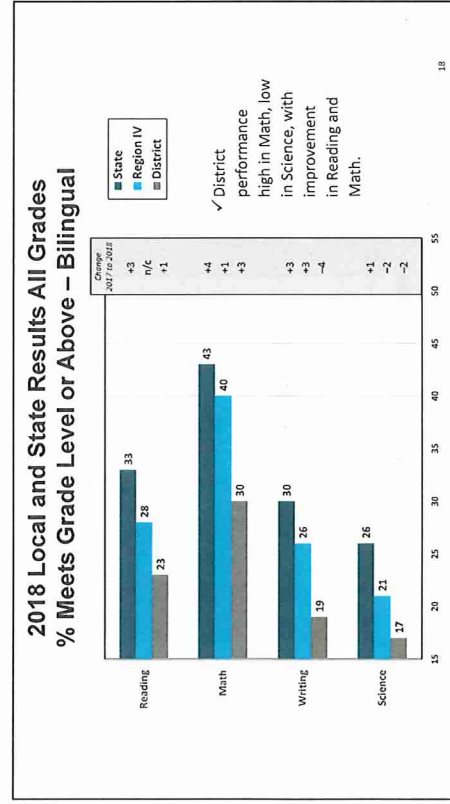
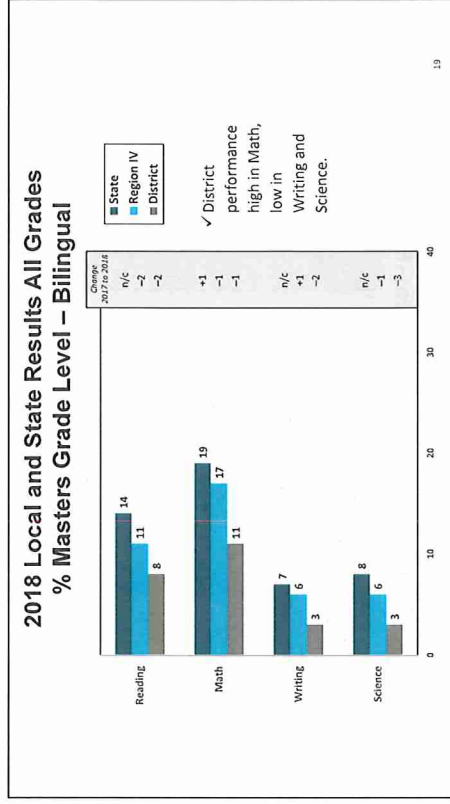
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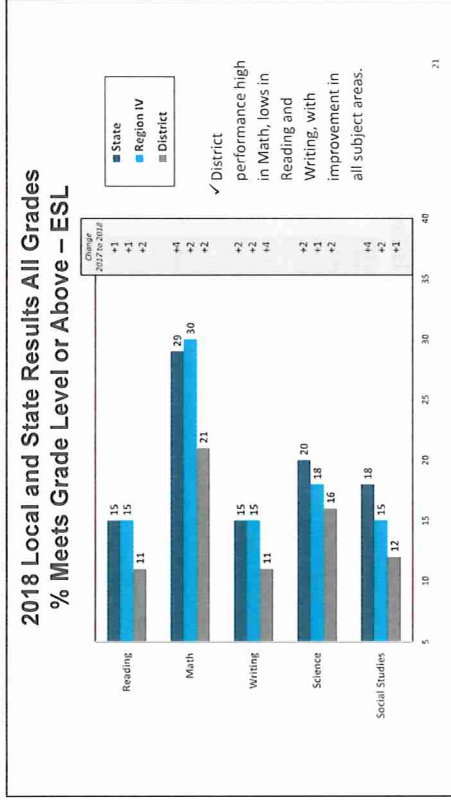
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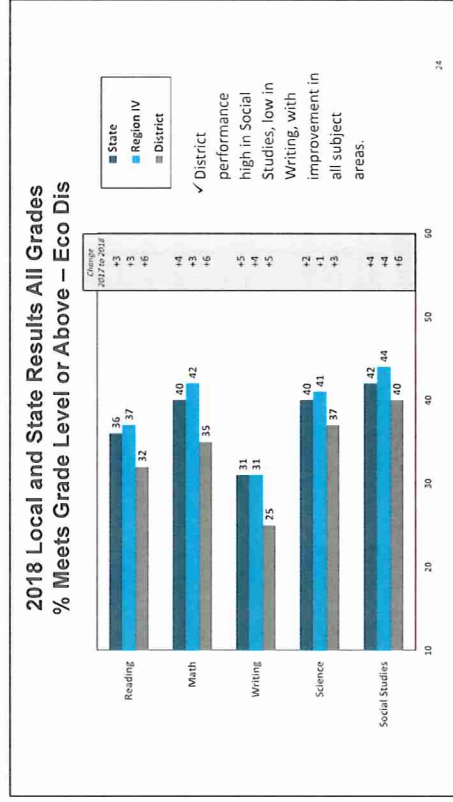
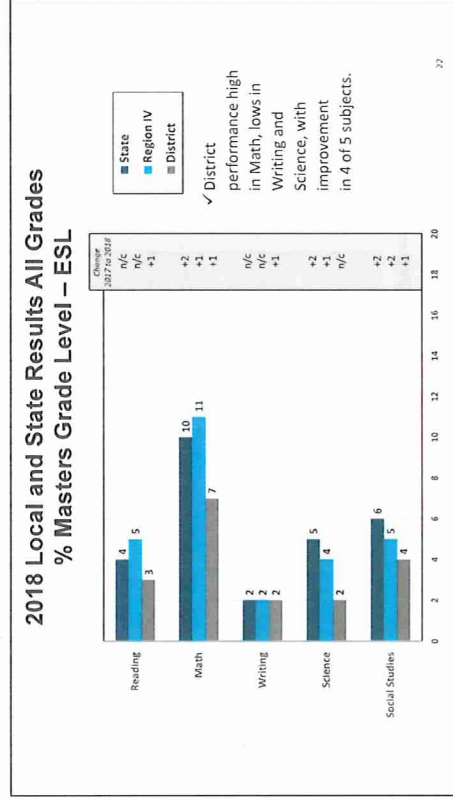
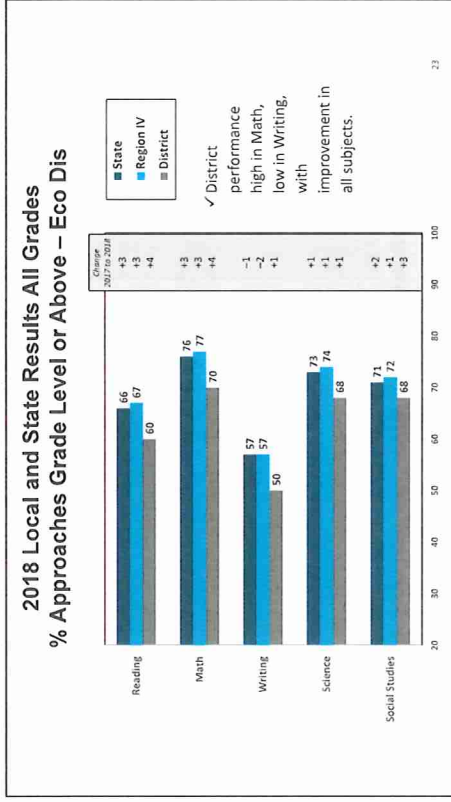
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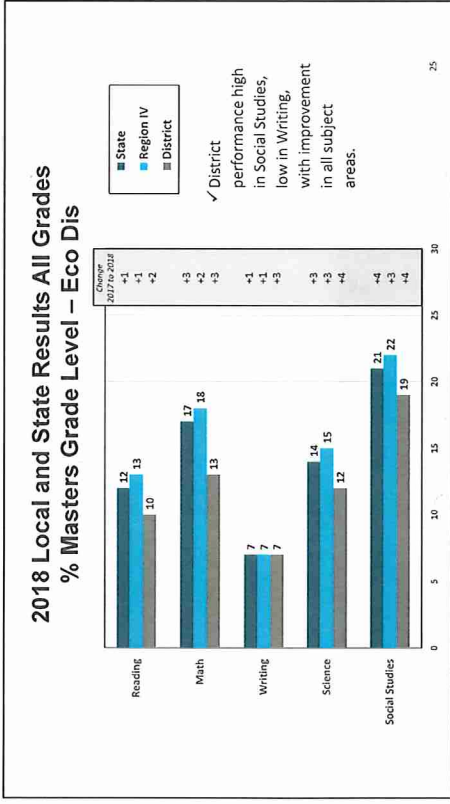
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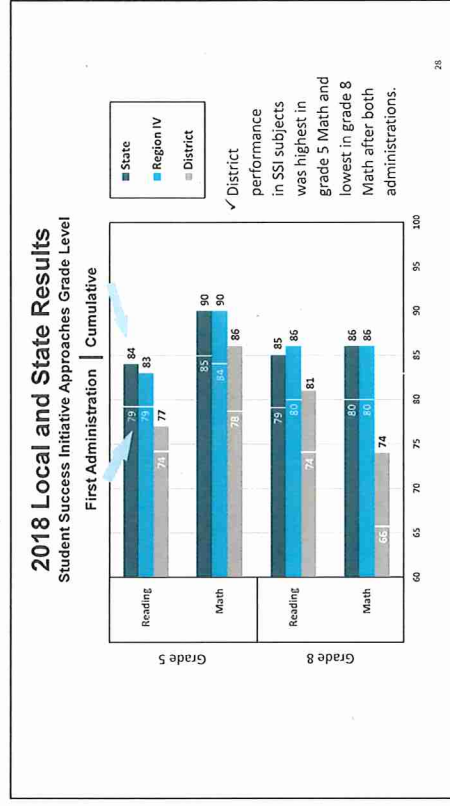
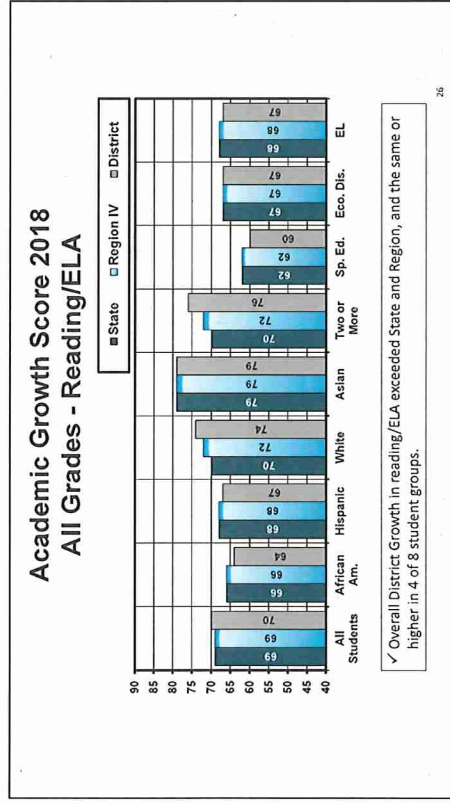
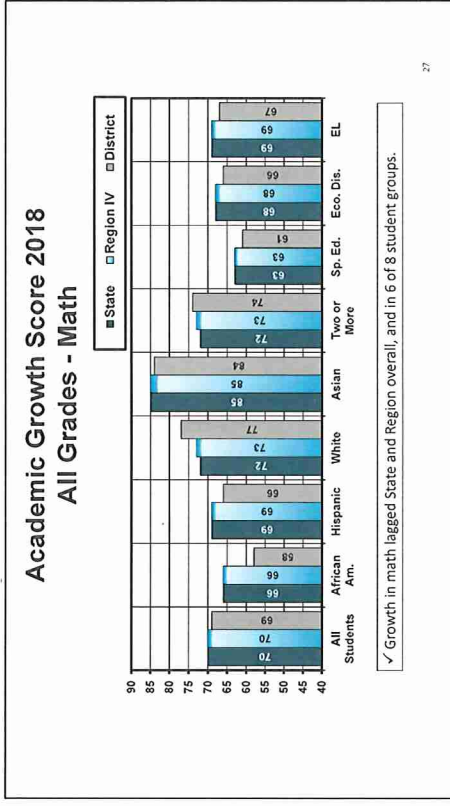
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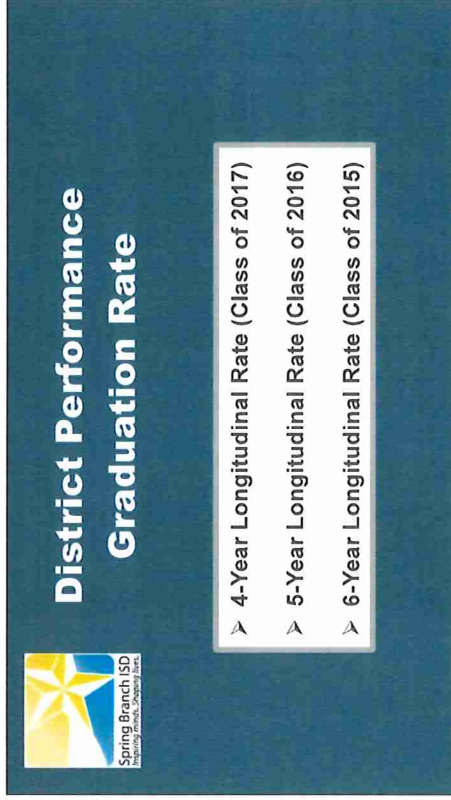
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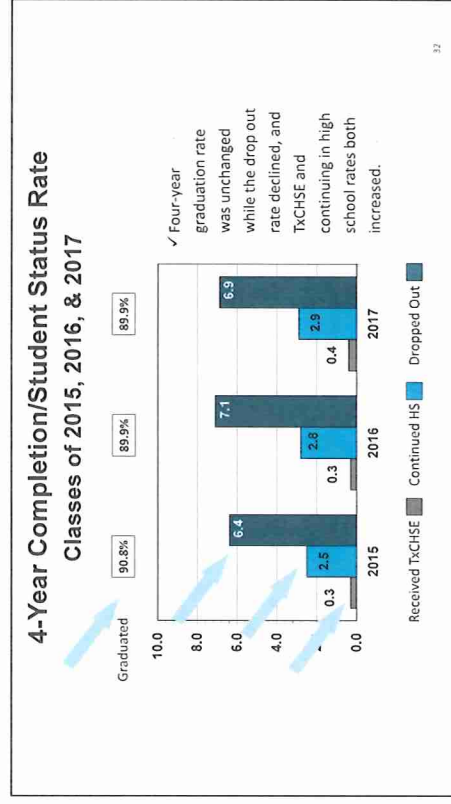
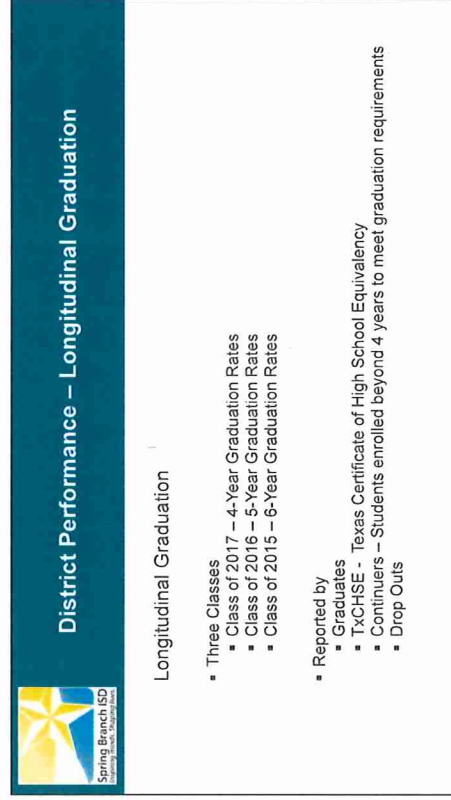
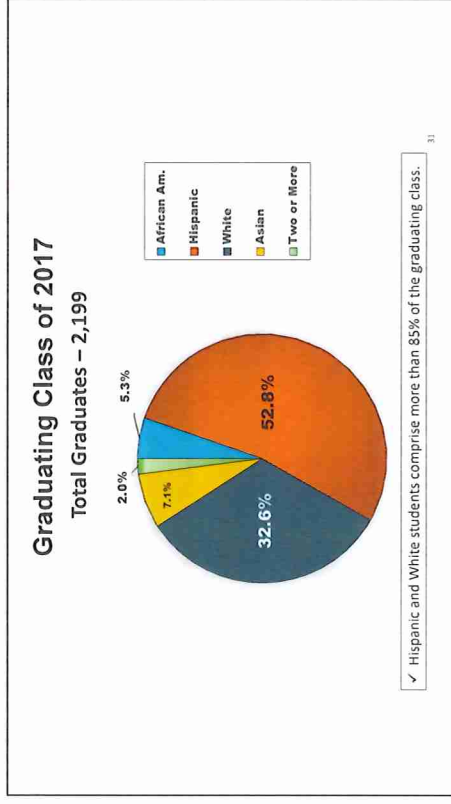
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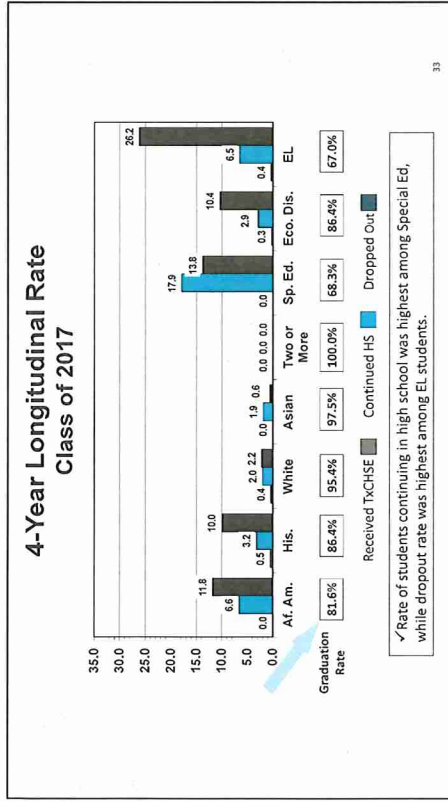
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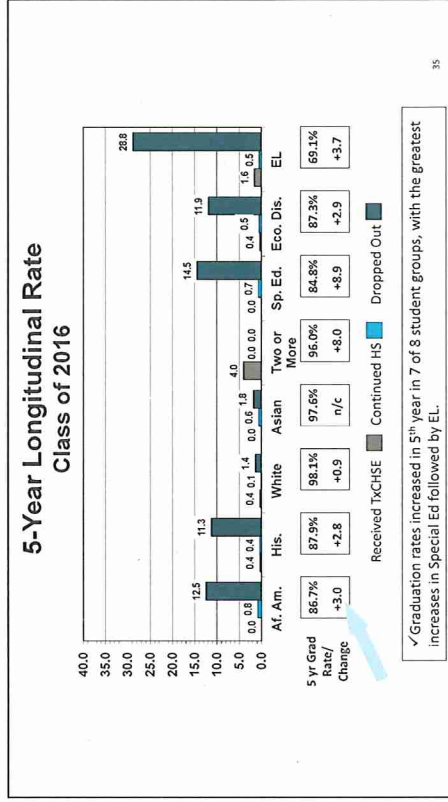
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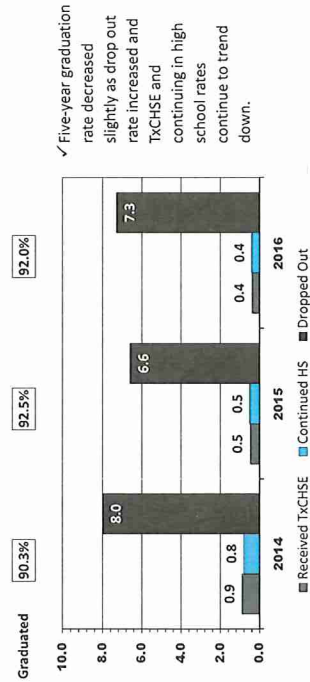
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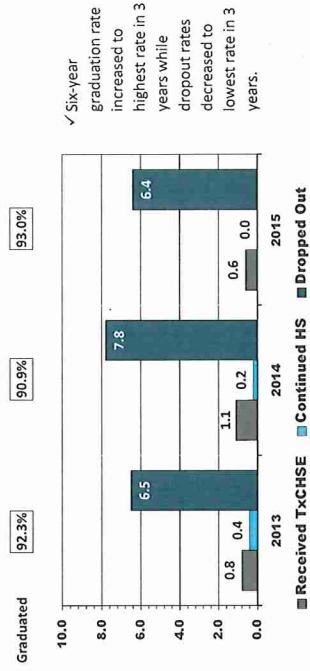
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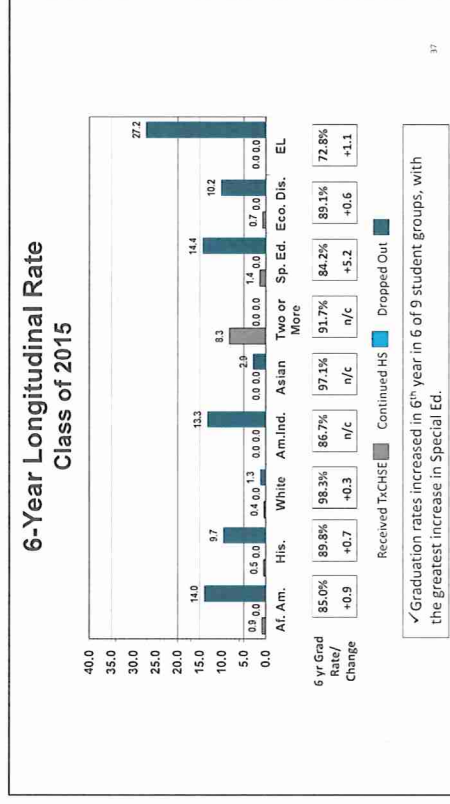
**5-Year Completion/Student Status Rate**

Class of 2017 Mean ACT Scores (Maximum Score 36)

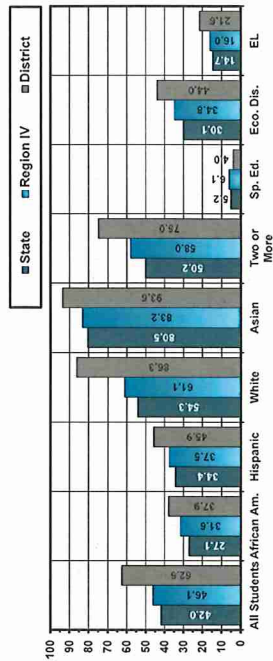

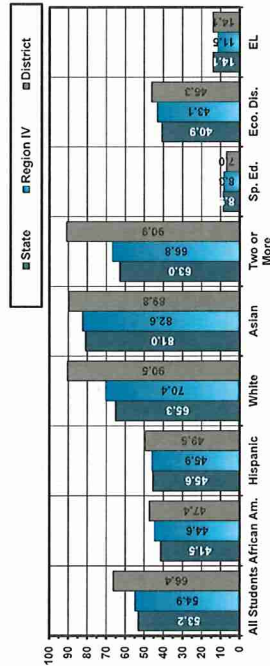
## College Ready Graduate Annual Graduation 2016-2017 Texas Success Initiative (TSI) Criteria - Math

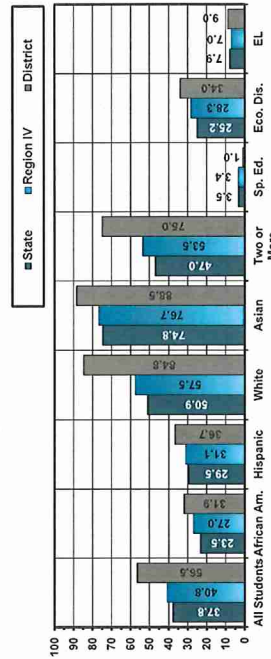

## College Ready Graduates Annual Graduation 2016-2017 Texas Success Initiative (TSI) Criteria - Both Subjects

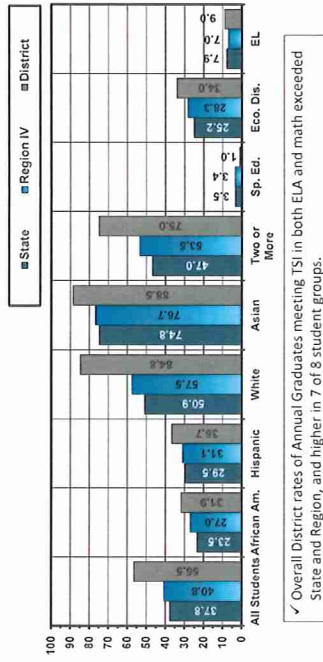

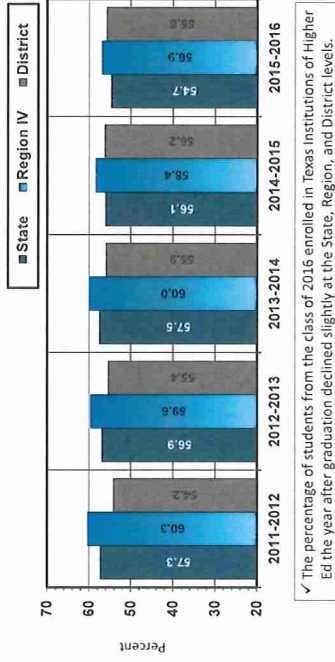
## College Ready Graduates Annual Graduate 2016-2017 Texas Success Initiation (TSI) Criteria - Both Subjects



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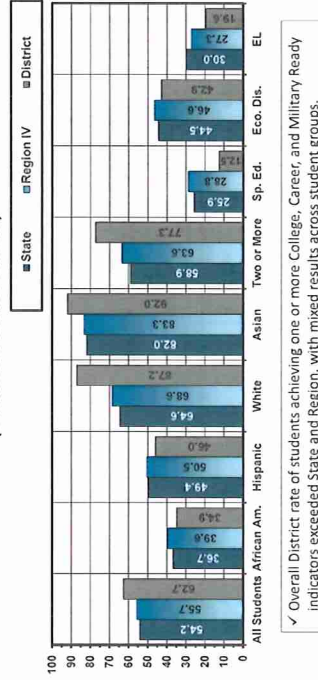

## School Violence Prevention and Violence Intervention Policies and Procedures 2018-2019

Maintaining safe and secure schools is the highest priority of the Spring Branch Independent School District. Some major components of the District's efforts to keep students safe are:

- A state certified Police Department, staffed by fully state certified Peace Officers to ensure student and staff safety and security.
- Enforcement of Local Ordinances, State and Federal law, and School Board policies to ensure the safety and security of students, staff, and visitors.
- Emergency operation plans for district campuses and facilities, enhanced student/parent unification plan.
- Each campus is required to conduct drills in the four main Standard Response Protocols which include "Lockout", "Lockdown", "Evacuate", and "Shelter" drills every year.
- Safety and Security Audits of District campuses are conducted per State requirements. Implementation of audits' findings address deficiencies and allow improvement on best practices for school safety.
- An Emergency Radio System notifies all campuses and departments of emergency situations involving weather, terrorist, or criminal activities requiring a Standard Response Protocol.
- Tactical training for SBISD Police Officers on "Active Shooter Response" including training on lessons learned from recent school and college shootings.
- Self-Aid/Buddy Aid Medical training for SBISD Police Officers.
- Develop and maintain policies and procedures related to school safety and security.
- Detailed and comprehensive policies for weapons, gang-related activities, assaults, racial intolerance, sexual harassment, drugs, alcohol, and bullying.
- Policies prohibiting disruptive activities on District property.
- Use of access control, burglar and fire alarms and Closed Circuit Television to protect students, staff, and property.
- Use of trained K-9s for patrol and the detection of explosives and drugs.
- Discipline alternative education program for students who commit serious discipline offenses.
- SBISD supplies Emergency Management Pocket Guides for all District Campus and Departmental Administrators.
- Training for administrators and staff using table top drills on Incident Command procedures following guidelines set by the National Incident Management System (NIMS).

# **Report of 2015-2016 High School Graduates' Enrollment and Academic Performance in Texas Public Higher Education in FY 2017**

Texas statute requires every school district to include, with their performance report, information received under Texas Education Code §51.403(e). This information, provided to districts from the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board (THECB), reports on student performance in postsecondary institutions during the first year enrolled after graduation from high school.

Student performance is measured by the Grade Point Average (GPA) earned by 2015-2016 high school graduates who attended public four-year and two-year higher education in FY 2017. The data is presented alphabetically for each county, school district and high school. The bookmarks can be used to select the first letter of a county. Then the user can scroll down to the desired county, school district and high school.

For each student, the grade points and college-level semester credit hours earned by a student in fall 2016, spring 2017, and summer 2017 are added together and averaged to determine the GPA. These GPAs are accumulated in a range of five categories from < 2.0 to > 3.5. If a GPA could not be calculated for some reason, that student is placed in the "Unknown" column. GPA data is only available for students attending public higher education institutions in Texas. If a high school has fewer than five students attending four-year or two-year public higher education institutions, the number of students is shown but no GPA breakout is given. If a student attended both a four-year and a two-year institution in FY 2017, the student's GPA is shown in the type of institution where the most semester credit hours were earned.

The number of students located at Texas independent institutions is presented. Also shown are "not trackable" graduates, those with non-standard ID numbers that cannot be used to match student identifiers at Texas higher education institutions. "Not found" graduates have standard ID numbers but were not located in FY 2017 at Texas higher education institutions. They might have enrolled in higher education outside of Texas.

No data is given for high schools with 25 or fewer graduates.

Because the statute calls for data on the first year enrolled after graduation, the level of the institution attended by students in this report may not match that given in THECB's high school to college report at <http://www.txhigheredata.org/Interactive/HSCollLink>. That report shows where students attended in the fall semester after their high school graduation year. This report attributes students to the level of institution where they earned the most semester credit hours during the whole academic year, not just the fall semester.

**Please note:** In May 2012 the 2006-2007, 2007-2008, and 2008-2009 versions of the *Report of High School Graduates' Enrollment and Academic Performance in Texas Public Higher Education* were updated to reflect a minor correction in how the GPA data are distributed across ranges.
