How to sign up for Access from AT&T

Check your eligibility for Access from AT&T <u>here</u>. Eligibility is determined by four programs: Supplemental Nutritional Access Program (SNAP), Supplemental Security Income (SSI) for California residents only, Income (temporary) and National School Lunch and Head Start Programs (temporary). Documentation will be required when applying.
