### **Career & Technology Education (CTE) Updates:**

- The CTE Dept. presented an update to the Board on April 22, 2019 on how SBISD is laying the groundwork for implementing the CTE Task Force's vision and recommendations.
- SBISD is contracting with Region 4 to consult on a CTE program portfolio evaluation to identify current and potential CTE programs SBISD should offer moving forward. Evaluation to be completed by Sept. 1, 2019.
- SBISD is contracting with IBI Architects to conduct an internal study of instructional spaces across the district currently housing CTE courses and programs. Report to be completed by Sept. 1, 2019.
- SBISD will convene a fall CTE working group to take the CTE Task Force's recommendations and develop a specific proposal regarding future CTE programming, facilities, staffing and more. Proposal will go to Board in December 2019.

### **Fine & Performing Arts Updates:**

- Over \$2,000,000 in band and orchestra instruments have been delivered.
- High school drill team uniforms replacement cycles began last year with Memorial HS.
  - Spring Woods HS Drill Team uniforms are set to be ordered this year.






